All volunteers must go to the ARA website and obtain a Volunteer License, if they have not previously done so for another ARA event earlier in the season. This is for insurance purposes, and is required for everyone. It should take about five minutes or less and is free. Parents should fill out the information for each child that is a minor; they will get a chance to sign the waiver for that child later in the process.

Scroll down to participant type, select Volunteer, and choose whether you will be attending more than one ARA event this year. Complete the personal information and events to attend, and hit Next Page at the bottom. You do NOT need to join as an ARA member.

Next you will need to fill out the personal insurance section and then agree to the terms below that. Hit Next Page.

You do not need to create an account or pay, just scroll down and hit Save Registration.

Choose "Add Another Registration" or "Continue to Billing" in the popup box (you don't need to pay anything!).

Almost done. Complete where to send the confirmation (name, email). Hit Submit.

Check your email. The email will be from American Rally Association. Scroll down to the box that says "Signature Required: Sign Here", hit that box.

A "Signature Required" page will open. Scroll down, put in your address and sign with your mouse. Note that parents/guardians can sign on behalf of their child here. Submit. "Thank you" will appear with a link to Download A Copy of Your Waiver. Do this and print on paper, or print as a PDF to save to your phone or computer.

You will receive another email with your information and a "QR" code. Some events want to see the QR code, so again, print it on paper or as a PDF file to save to your phone.
